COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT

**SCBA/ Interior Firefighting Operations – FFI – Segment 2
August 15 through October 3, 2019**

Interior Firefighting Operations (IFO) is part 2 of the NYS Firefighter 1 series. This class builds on the knowledge gained in BEFO and provides additional skills necessary for the firefighter who will be conducting interior fire attack. The student will learn how to operate in various environments using a self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) along with a variety of other firefighting skills such as: building searches, suppression of structural fires, tactics, vehicle suppression, and building ventilation.

Student Prerequisites: Students must have already completed (or have bridged into) the New 2016 BEFO course to be eligible to take SCBA / Interior Firefighting Operations - Firefighter-1.

Each student is required to bring a “New York State Training Authorization Letter” signed by the chief to the first class.

The instructor will be Sean McAdoo.
