### ***TITLE VI NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC*** (displayed in Ontario County facilities)

Ontario County is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in, or denied the benefits of its services on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, low income or Limited English Proficiency (LEP) status.
